AVAILABILITY:

Available to all residential consumers and churches who required less than 50 kVA transformer capacity or to commercial consumers who requires less than 10 kVA transformer capacity within the Utility's service area and who maintain residence in the same premise for nine (9) months or more per year.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Alternating current, single and/or three-phase, 60 Hertz, at available secondary voltages.

NET RATE PER BILLING PERIOD: (or part thereof/service)

\$25.00 per billing period (System Charge)

-PLUS-

All kWh per billing period @ \$.1165/kWh

The system charge shall cover costs of providing electric service, including operation and maintenance of facilities, consumer accounting expenses and other administrative costs.

ANNUAL RATE/YEAR:

Upon request of the consumer and for their convenience, the Utility will render one bill annually payable in advance. The annual charges will be estimated by the Utility, based on billing period minimum rate charges, established contracts, or on prior years' usage. If prior years' usage is utilized, the average annual prior years' usage shall be divided by 12 and allocated to each future billing period. For the first 11 billing periods, a system charge of \$25.00 per billing period per service plus the above kWh rate blocks shall be applied to each service and its associated estimated kWh usage. The calculated bill will be subtracted from the consumer's prepaid balance. The twelfth billing period shall be an adjusted bill consisting of the \$25.00 system charge plus the kWh charge adjustment to the consumer's actual annual usage.

MINIMUM BILLING PERIOD CHARGES:

The billing period minimum charges shall be the highest of the following:

- (1) \$25.00 per billing period with no allowance for kWh.
- (2) Minimum charges established in accordance with Line Extension Policy. No power allowed for the first \$25.00.
- (3) All consumers requiring more than 10 kVA transformer capacity shall be charged an additional \$1.25 per kVA of transformer capacity in excess of 10 kVA for which power usage will be allowed at the foregoing rates. This charge shall be in addition to the system charge of \$25.00 (no kWh allowance in system charge).

MINIMUM CHARGES: (Continued)

Capacity and energy allowances shall be made only during the billing period in which they occurred.

- (4) Minimum charges established by special contract between the consumer and the Utility. This charge shall be in addition to the system charge of \$25.00 (no kWh allowance in system charge).

DEBT COST ADJUSTMENT:

Billings under this schedule shall be increased or decreased by the change in the current debt cost from the debt cost utilized in establishing the present rates, in accordance with NMPRC Rule No. 17.9.540 NMAC.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of Ad Valorem, State and Federal Income Taxes) payable by the Utility and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The utility shall, if the fuel and purchased power expense is increased or decreased above or below the base purchased power cost of \$.088559/kWh sold, flow through to the users such increases or decreases, in accordance with New Mexico Public Regulation Commission Rule No. 550 (17.9.550 NMAC).

RENEWABLE ENERGY AND CONSERVATION FEE:

At the discretion of the Board of Trustees of Mora-San Miguel Electric Cooperative Inc., the Cooperative may assess and collect a fee of up to 1% of the retail bill to be deposited into a segregated fund with the sole purpose of acquiring renewable energy or providing conservation or load management programs for the benefit of the members as more specifically set forth in NMSA 1978 Section 62-15-36. X

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The charges per billing period in the foregoing rates are net, and due and payable within twenty (20) days from the date on the bill.

BILLING PERIOD:

The billing period shall be approximately 1/12 of a year, but not necessarily a calendar month.

BUDGET BILLING:

Upon the request of the consumer and for their convenience, the Utility will provide budget billing in accordance with the rules and regulations filed by the Utility and approved by the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission.

TEMPORARY OR UNUSUAL SERVICE

Temporary or unusual service will be covered by the Utility's Rules and Regulations. In such cases, the minimum charges, conditions of furnishing substation equipment, connection and disconnection of service and special conditions will be covered by special agreement with the customer. The customer shall pay for all expenses involved in furnishing the temporary service.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- (1) The Utility's Rules and Regulations, filed with the regulatory body shall apply.
- (2) All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment electrically on the load side of the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
